For your comfort, we recommend bringing a 3mm wetsuit with a vest or a 5mm wetsuit, especially if you plan to dive frequently. Additional layers are available for rent if you find you need more warmth.

While macro photography and critters are our primary focus, we also venture outside the strait to explore beautiful wide-angle opportunities. Visibility is occasionally excellent, reaching up to 40 meters on the East of Lembeh. Inside the strait, average visibility is around 10 meters, but for our purposes, visibility is rarely a concern.
