
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MV SOLITUDE ONE

Solitude One, originally a Japanese merchant vessel, has undergone a transformation to raise the standards of quality service and professionalism in the diving hospitality industry. The primary focus of Solitude One is the safety and comfort of its clients, and it has been meticulously constructed with intelligent designs, functional features, and a cosy ambience reminiscent of home, all while infusing a delicate sense of thoughtfulness. The well-trained staff onboard cater to every guest, addressing them by name, anticipating their individual needs, and appearing only when necessary, thereby ensuring the privacy and familiarity of a 'home away from home' experience.

Despite its rugged and sturdy exterior, Solitude One is far from ordinary. This floating sanctuary stretches over 52 meters and encompasses four decks, providing a remarkable experience. With a total of 10 ensuite cabins, Solitude One can comfortably accommodate up to 24 guests. The cabins are spread across two floors and include two state rooms, seven deluxe cabins, and one quad share cabin.


Solitude One boasts one of the most spacious dive decks, complete with rinse tanks for diving equipment and cameras, hot and cold showers, and ample racks for all diving paraphernalia. Additionally, the vessel provides Enriched Air Nitrox and equipment rental services. For added convenience, complimentary items such as the Nautilus lifeline (GPS-VHS radio), SMBs, and Reef Hooks are available if needed.

When not engaged in diving activities, guests have the opportunity to relax in the lounge while watching watch movies, play games, or work on photos in the dedicated camera room. The vessel also offers a spacious weather deck for sunbathing and a jacuzzi for a refreshing dip. Furthermore, even after enjoying the five meals provided each day in the form of buffets, guests can indulge in cup noodles, cookies, cakes, candy, and an abundance of tea, coffee, and soda.

Safety is of paramount importance on Solitude One, as the vessel is equipped with state-of-the-art communication, navigation, and safety technology. The crew is well-trained and prepared to execute all emergency and non-emergency procedures, while each skiff is equipped with first aid kits and medical oxygen.

Solitude One operates in Palau from October to March and in the Philippines from April to September.






NO SOLO diving is allowed, even if you are certified.

It is mandatory for all guests engaging in scuba activities to have an audible signalling device (such as a whistle), a dive computer, a surface marker buoy, appropriate dive insurance coverage, a valid dive certification, and have completed waiver forms A and C for the activities.



Day 1, Embarkation at Puerto Princesa

Check-in for the cruise begins at 1400Hrs at Puerto Princesa Harbour. Transfers from Puerto Princesa Domestic Airport are included in the cruise package. If you require transportation from your hotel or resort to the embarkation point, Solitude can arrange it through a third-party transportation company, subject to applicable charges. The cost of transfers will vary depending on your location. It is recommended that you coordinate directly with your hotel/resort for a transfer to the embarkation point or to Puerto Princesa Domestic Airport Terminal, where our team can pick you up starting from 1400Hrs.

Upon boarding Solitude One, our friendly crew will warmly welcome you. Once welcomed, we will proceed with the orientation and registration process (don't forget to bring your C-Cards and/ or Log Books!). To make the most of your time and ensure a smooth check-in, we encourage you to complete your registration and general liability release forms before boarding. However, if you haven't done so, there's no need to worry as you can fill them out after the orientation and hand them to your cruise directors. During the registration, we will also collect the necessary Permit and National Park fees. For detailed information on fees, please refer to our "Know-Before-You-Go" document. Dinner is included, and as the sun sets, Solitude One will begin its journey towards Tubbataha Reef National Park.

A Note About the Dive Sites

To ensure a pleasant diving experience, the dive sites in Tubbataha Reefs will be carefully scheduled, taking into account tides, currents, and coordination with other liveaboards in the area. This approach helps prevent overcrowding at any specific dive site, allowing for a more enjoyable exploration of the underwater wonders. By considering these factors and communicating with other dive operators, we aim to provide a well-managed and uncrowded

diving environment, maximising your opportunities to discover the beauty of Tubbataha Reefs.







This arrangement ensures a seamless transition back to the expedition's starting point.



Lembeh Strait, one of the most famous dive destinations in the world, is an absolute must for divers venturing to Indonesia.

Lembeh has become world renowned for its plethora and diversity of critters with many found only in the local area such as the Hairy Octopus or Lembeh Sea Dragon.

Divers can expect mild currents, low surge and shallow sites, making the area suitable for divers of all experience levels from a beginner to the veteran photographer. The water temperature varies depending on the time of the year, with the lowest being in July and August when the temperature drops to around 25°-26° degrees Celsius or 79°-81° Fahrenheit. Please refer to page 8 for our Water Temperature Guide. To ensure your comfort we recommend that you bring a 3mm with a vest or a 5mm wetsuit, especially if you are planning on doing several long dives a day. We have additional layers for rent if you find you need more warmth.

Our primary focus is on macro and critters, so visibility is not typically a major concern for us. Nevertheless, it is worth noting that we occasionally encounter excellent visibility of up to 40 meters on the East of Lembeh, while inside the strait, the average visibility is around 10 meters.
